Member Insurance Requirements

Aircraft Damage Liability

- The Member that is scheduled for and rents the airplane is responsible for any damage to the airplane that occurs during the flight.
- → Members are liable for Loss of Use compensation for incidents that ground an aircraft for more than 4 days.
- Members who encounter maintenance issues away from San Carlos are responsible for the costs of ferry and transportation, and any instructor costs involved in recovering the stranded aircraft.
- → SCFC insurance provides \$1,000,000 liability combined single limit for bodily injury and property damage for each occurrence, with sub-limit of \$100,000 per person with a pilot-paid deductible. Members are liable for an amount of \$5,000 to cover the deductible, Loss of Use, and other costs associated with the incident.

Renters (Non-Owned) Insurance

- SCFC Members are required to obtain a Renters (Non-Owned) Insurance policy with at least \$5,000 coverage for Aircraft Physical Damage.
- I acknowledge that I have been made aware of the pilot deductible of \$5,000 that I am liable for paying in the event of any damage during my rental.
- → I authorize San Carlos Flight Center to charge my member account in the event of any damage, or additional Loss of Use charges, if applicable.
- I understand that I must seek reimbursement from my Renters Insurance provider for these costs.
- If my coverage lapses for any reason, I understand that I am still personally liable to cover the deductible.
- If at any time I obtain or change policies, I will provide San Carlos Flight Center with a copy of the policy.
